According to a study in the *Journal of Investigative Dermatology*, facial skin has a light-sensitive circadian rhythm (biological clock) and focuses on recovery and rejuvenation when night falls. In this part of the world, we may also need more help. "Asian skin frequently suffers from dehydration and this can put a burden on the skin's natural ability to self-repair at night," says Dr Li Li of Sichuan University's West China Hospital.

Gently does it
 With 58,000 fine hairs vibrating at 20,000 cycles a minute, **Mimian Sonic Brush** (\$250, Clariancy Aesthetic Clinic) gives skin a light but thorough exfoliation. Its heated holder helps keep the brush dry and hygienic.



Up to speed
 The battery-operated **Neutrogena Wave Duo** (\$16.10, leading pharmacies) is a vibrating applicator with replaceable foaming pads. Click once for a mild massage; twice for a grime-purging clean.



Banish that blemish
 The bristles of **Garnier Pure Active Exfo-brusher** (\$18.90, leading pharmacies) look sharp but yield to the touch. Its cleansing gel contains two per cent salicylic acid to combat zits and leaves skin tingling fresh.



Soothe and smooth
 We like the handy scrublet that comes with **L'Oréal Paris Perfect Clean** (\$14.90, Watsons). Add a dollop of cleanser onto it and it'll lather up gently on the face. The fragrance-free cream wash is suitable for dry skin.
