### ➔ She's Aladdin Genie Skincare Device

**Why you need this:**

Because it's damn cute. Not a good enough reason? Okay, the gold-plated stick uses vibratory massage to allow creams and serums to better permeate skin.

**How it works:** It's magic, pure and simple. Fine, the device uses the power of ions to massage nutrients more effectively into skin, and to reduce wrinkles.

### ➔ Mimian Sonic Facial Brush

**Why you need this:** Because simply rubbing on the face wash and rinsing doesn't cut it anymore. This baby from Korea removes six times more make-up than manual cleansing.

**How it works:** Spread facial foam on face. Turn on the device — don't worry, it's waterproof. When it beeps, apply the whirring brush to your forehead for 15 seconds. The right cheek, left cheek and chin along with nose get 15 seconds each. Besides reducing oiliness, blemishes and pores, it increases absorption of creams and serums.

**Does it work?** We tried it for a couple of days, and skin did feel cleaner and less oily. Besides, playing with electronic objects in the shower is fun.

### ➔ Bling Bling Mini
